Having examined the Irish Constitutional and legislative provisions for divorce, it is concluded that while prenuptial agreements are not provided for, they are not excluded either. By analogy with a recent Irish Supreme decision which held that a 'clean break' approach is permissible in Irish law because such an approach is not specifically excluded by the legislation, it is possible to envisage a situation where some limited effect would be given to prenuptial agreements in Ireland (with the proviso that any such agreement meet the statutory requirement of 'proper provision' for the spouses). Tests with regard to the enforceability of prenuptial agreements include tests as to whether procedural formalities have been observed, and tests as to the substantive effect of the agreement.
